

the way that his grandmother had shaped their lives. I left feeling thankful before God for such a long life of faith and service on her part. My debt to her in shaping Bruce into someone who could be such a faithful friend is beyond my ability to pay.

Do you think about the memories you are shaping? They happen so incidentally. Each Sunday evening after church services in Stafford, the Turner's and Feril's met for pizza. Our boys watched Star Wars while the adults visited in the kitchen until it was time to eat and play cards. All of the kids played and we had "forever teams" who played each other each week. The competition was ferocious, at least the kids thought it was. We were just enjoying a social time, but the reality was that we were making memories.

Those times contributed to our being together here in ministry. We don't spend the volume of time together now that we did when our children were young, but when we do, we drop right back into the same rhythms. We laugh at similar things, share familiar memories and create new ones.

What will define your relationships? Who are the ones that you allow to have that level of influence? How do you move intentionally to accomplish it? These are all important questions, not just because they define your family... but because they are the way you present the gracious message of Jesus to the world around you.

A.C. will begin preaching at the age of 20 and will continue preaching until the age of 101, for a total of 81 years of preaching ministry. He will die (Dec. 8, 1967) just two months shy of his 104th birthday, having at that time 42 great-great grandchildren.

I thought it was incredible that this brother was able to speak of the gracious nature of our God each week for 81 years. What a wonderful history and thing for which to be remembered.
